BELIEFS FOR DOMINION HOLY GHOST DELIVERANCE TABERNACLE

We believe in the divine inspiration of the Word of God and in the eternal existence of God in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost. Jesus Christ is the only begotten Son of the Father, conceived by the Holy Ghost and born of the virgin, Mary. We acknowledge that all have sinned and fall short of God's glory, and that repentance is commanded by God for all and is essential for the forgiveness of sins. Justification, regeneration, and the new birth are achieved through faith in the blood of Christ, by the Word, and the Holy Ghost. God's standard for living is holiness, and the baptism with the Holy Ghost follows a clean heart. Speaking with other tongues as the Spirit gives utterance is the evidence of the Holy Spirit. We believe in water baptism by immersion and that all who repent should be baptized in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost. Divine healing is provided for all in the atonement. We observe the Lord's Supper and the washing of the saints' feet. We believe in the second coming of Jesus: first, to resurrect the righteous dead and catch away the living saints to Him in the air, and second, to reign on the earth for one thousand years. Lastly, we believe in the bodily resurrection, eternal life for the righteous, and eternal punishment for the wicked.
